	Topic	Quirky Stories - Julia Donaldson and Eric Carle.
	Communication and Language	Talking about important past events for the family; listening and retelling of topic-related stories; rhyme and alliteration in stories; learning about descriptive words/language, role-play opportunities; discussions relating to our world using a wide range of vocabulary and using more complex sentences.
	Understanding of the World	ICT- Bee-Bots on maps; learning about different people and traditions; learning about authors' backgrounds; creating and reading maps; looking at similarities and differences between environments.
	Personal, Social and Emotional Development	Reinforcing the golden rules; sharing and turn-taking activities; discussion about feelings and emotions; considering others' interests and feelings; conflict resolution, road safety and behaviour on outings – Leicester Square Theatre.
	Expressive Art and Design	Topic-related songs; use of puppets; weekly dance and music lessons; clay and modelling; role-play opportunities; drawing, painting and collage activities.
	French	French food, animals and weather.
	Music	Pitch, texture and rhythm through songs and instruments.
	Physical Development	Observe effects of exercise on our bodies; explore different ways of moving; ball and chasing games; Funky Finger activities; personal hygiene and germs; weekly dance and gymnastics lessons; weekly PE lessons; daily handwriting practice.
