Headmaster Tim Cannell comments: 'my vision is for a school that opens children's eyes to the future, instils a hunger for learning and allows them to live their lives to the full while enjoying all that childhood has to offer. If we get this right PGP will continue to be one of the best preps in West London, ensuring that the children have a positive view of themselves as well as developing the skills needed to be successful in a rapidly changing world.'

Academic Record: Year 6 leavers have consistently received multiple offers from some of the UK's best schools in recent years.

Extra-curricular: PGP runs a busy and diverse programme of morning and after-school clubs. These include football with Chelsea FC's Foundation, fencing, art, coding, STEM club, chamber choir, running and Young Engineers. Our LAMDA lessons are exceptional and our children have done extremely well in this area.

Notable Achievements and Alumni: We won the ISA award for Outstanding Provision in STEM for 2016/17. We regularly compete in ISA sports tournaments and win medals. The children and staff organise charity fundraising throughout the year, with an emphasis on our local community. We are working towards the Fairachiever School Award (the highest level).
